Safety Measures - Training at Pilz UK HQ

Pilz UK are delighted to announce the return of training courses at our purpose-built facility in Corby. Your health and safety whilst you train with us is our highest priority, so we have introduced the following procedures to ensure our building is as safe as possible in regards to the current Covid-19 pandemic:

▶ Medical declaration form to be completed by all attending delegates before course commences, ensuring those who are showing symptoms of Covid-19 do not attend the training.

▶ Prior to each training course, all our building and facilities will be subjected to a thorough professional cleaning process. Touchpoints and training aids in the training room will be cleaned thoroughly before and after use.

▶ Delegates will be required to have their temperature checked using a non-contact thermometer before being admitted to the building. If temperature is normal (36.1°C - 37.2°C) delegates will then be required to make use of the hand-sanitiser and or antiseptic wipes, that we will be providing, when entering or leaving the building and training room.

▶ Entry to the building and access to the training room and other facilities to be used within the building has been redesigned to avoid touch points.

▶ Our training room has been reorganised and for all training we will be implementing a maximum class size of 8 delegates, which allows for a minimum of 2-metres of personal separation whilst in the room.

▶ The use of PPE, although not mandatory, is not discouraged. Delegates to bring any PPE they may require.

▶ In order to avoid any possibility of cross-contamination via food preparation, delegates will be provided with individually prepared lunches. Tea and coffee will still be provided, with guidelines in place for the facilities to limit contact. Delegates are encouraged to bring their own water bottles and may refill as required, however bottled water will be available.

▶ We will follow any government health and safety and risk assessment guidelines as appropriate at the time of the training course.
